Greetings from Ghana!

I am most delighted to inform you that I received notification yesterday from the Advance of GBGM of your covenant support for me as your new Missionary. This is just a short note to indicate my appreciation and that of my family for the wonderful support. We will be looking forward to a very good relationship over the period of your support. Thank you also for your prayers for me, my family and for my mission.

God willing, I will travel to Liberia on May 16 together with two volunteers from Compatible Technology International, (CTI), MN, for a period of about 2 weeks. We will be working with communities there in using Omega VI grinders, fabricated by CTI for the grinding of Moringa into fine powder for use in nutrition and feeding programs in that country.

The Omega VI grinders can also be used to grind roasted peanuts into peanut butter. We conducted similar trials very successfully last year and this will be a follow up mission. I will also be working with some groups in Liberia to develop modalities for them to take ownership of some of these grinders on a micro-loan basis and to develop mechanisms for paying back with time for use of the grinders so others could benefit on the basis of a revolving scheme.

Please pray for us as we undertake these travels and also for a successful mission.
