Logo Description:

- The blue swirl, ending in a shape symbolizing wind, represents Worship, the movement of the Holy Spirit that flows inward, outward, and around our coming together.
- The green swirl, ending in a leaf shape, represents Learning and growing in faith, as we explore meaning and mystery in the Bible and are transformed in Christ.
- The orange swirl, ending in a hand shape, represents Serving, as we reach outward into the world, engaging in ministries of love, justice, and witness
